






The fourth measure of the first ending, featuring a hi-hat pattern of eighth notes and a bass drum on the first beat, with a snare drum on the second beat.




The fifth measure of the first ending, featuring a hi-hat pattern of eighth notes and a bass drum on the first beat, with a snare drum on the second beat.




The sixth measure of the first ending, featuring a hi-hat pattern of eighth notes and a bass drum on the first beat, with a snare drum on the second beat.




The seventh measure of the first ending, featuring a hi-hat pattern of eighth notes and a bass drum on the first beat, with a snare drum on the second beat.
